Dear Members of Congress:

I am writing in response to your letter dated February 6, 2019, requesting that the Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of the Inspector General (OIG) review the conditions at the Federal Bureau of Prisons' (BOP) Metropolitan Detention Center in Brooklyn, New York (MDC Brooklyn) and management practices at the facility.

On February 7, 2019, the OIG initiated an inspection and review of BOP's management of the electrical and heating issues that occurred beginning in January 2019 at the MDC. That same day, the OIG conducted an initial site visit, inspection of the facility, and began conducting interviews.

The OIG will assess how the conditions referenced in your letter occurred, whether BOP has in place adequate contingency plans for such an incident, and how the situation affected prisoners' conditions of confinement and access to counsel. The OIG will also assess steps BOP management officials took to address and resolve those issues. If circumstances warrant, the OIG will consider including other issues that may arise during the course of the inspection and review. We will publicly report our findings and recommendations.
