By upgrading these elevators, the project will enhance daily convenience, improve safety, and ensure that all residents, particularly the most vulnerable, have consistent and dependable access to their homes. Additionally, modern and efficient elevators can also contribute to the overall energy efficiency of the building, reducing maintenance costs and downtime, and ultimately providing a more sustainable and comfortable living environment for all residents.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
